

VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE-NARROWS

BY-LAW NO. 2

A BY-LAW TO BOND ELECTED OFFICIALS AND STAFF

BE IT ENACTED BY the Mayor and Councillors of the Village of Cambridge Narrows as follows:

1. When used in the By-Law, the words defined in Section 84.(1) of the Municipalities Act 1995-09, and amendments thereto, shall have the same meaning as in the said Act.

2. No person or persons shall be elected to serve on Council or be appointed by Council to hold the office of Clerk-Treasurer or Assistant Clerk-Treasurer until it has been affirmed that he/she will diligently, faithfully and impartially and to the best of his/her ability, discharge the several duties appertaining to the office to which he/she has been appointed so long as he/she shall hold the same and that he/she obey the By-Laws of the Village and the Municipalities Act 1995-09 under Sections 76 and 77 and the Assistant Clerk-Treasurer obey the By-Laws of the Village *of* and the Municipalities Act 1995-009 under Section 76(2) and 77(2) and shall give security by bond in such sum as the Council may from time to time fix for the faithful performance of his/her duties which bond shall be deposited with the Village Clerk for safekeeping.
