

BY-LAW NO. 6
A BY-LAW RESPECTING DOG CONTROL IN ARCADIA



The Council of Arcadia, under the authority vested in it by the *Local Governance Act, SNB 2017, c18*;

WHEREAS Section 10(1)(k) of the *Local Governance Act* states that a local government may make by-laws for municipal purposes respecting wild, domestic, and exotic animals and activities in relation to them, including animal control activities;

AND WHEREAS Sections 10(2)(c) and (d) of the *Local Governance Act* state that a local government shall make by-laws imposing a requirement that dogs be vaccinated against rabies, and prescribing requirements for the proof of vaccination of dogs or requirements for the assessment of the effectiveness of a previous vaccination;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Arcadia as follows:

1) TITLE

- a) This by-law shall be cited as the “Dog Control By-law”.

2) PURPOSE

- a) This by-law is enacted for the purpose of dog control.

3) DEFINITIONS

- a) “**Dog Control Officer**” means the person(s), group, or organization appointed by the Council to administer this by-law.

4) APPLICATION

- a) This by-law applies to all residents of Arcadia.

5) OPERATIONS

- a) Arcadia will engage the services of a Dog Control Officer to carry out the operations of the control of dogs in Arcadia.

- b) The Dog Control Officer shall follow *New Brunswick Regulation 2022-36*, and its revisions and updates, when it conducts the control of dogs within Arcadia.

6) REPEAL OF EXISTING BY-LAWS

- a) The enactment of this by-law repeals the following by-laws:
 - i) By-law #8: Village of Cambridge-Narrows – A By-law Respecting Animal Control
 - ii) By-law #33: Village of Gagetown – A By-law Respecting Animal Control
- b) The repeal of the above by-laws shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal, or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal defeat, disturb, invalidate, or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing, or pending at the time of repeal.

7) ENACTMENT

- a) IN WITNESS WHEREOF the local government of Arcadia has caused its corporate seal to be affixed to this by-law.
